

2019 High School Summer Reading

For all students:

- A **FICTION** book is required to be from a Christian publisher (ex. Tyndale, Bethany House, Moody Publishers, Multnomah, Howard Books, Baker Publishing Group, Revell, etc.)
- You must purchase the actual book (no library books, e-books, audio books, etc.). Used books are acceptable.
- Book must be completely read by the first day of school.
- Bring your book on the first day of school – this is your first assignment.

Grade Level Requirements:

9th grade: at least 250 pages

10th grade: at least 350 pages

11th grade: 2 books of at least 250 pages each

12th grade: 2 books of at least 300 pages each
